A New InterContinental Resort Is Coming to the Caribbean

Range Developments, the company behind the Park Hyatt St Kitts and Kempinski Dominica, among others, is developing a new Intercontinental resort on the island of Grenada.

The project will complement Range's existing Six Senses Grenada resort project, forming a broader tourism complex in the St David's parish of Grenada.



“Range is delighted to expand our relationship with the IHG Group with today’s signing,” said Mohammed Asaria, founder and managing director of Range Developments, told Caribbean Journal Invest. “Our La Sagesse Master Planned Tourism Community will personify Caribbean luxury tourism. It will encompass the Six Senses Grenada which is on track for timely completion in Q1 2024 and the Intercontinental Grenada.”

Both the Six Senses and the Intercontinental will be residential resorts; Six Senses and Intercontinental are both part of the IHG global brand portfolio.



It's the fourth luxury hotel development for Range.

We have “clearly cemented ourselves as the market leading Caribbean CBI hotel developer,” Asaria told Caribbean Journal Invest.

Asaria said the “character and flair of Grenada would be infused into the development of the hotel.”



It's part of a growing luxury hotel pipeline in Grenada, one that kicked off with the debut of the Silversands Grenada and now includes the Six Senses, Intercontinental and the still-in-development Kimpton Kawana Bay resort, another IHG-branded property.
