### Work on first citizenship project begins in Dominica

ROSEAU. Dominica (CBN4) -- Work on the Cabrits Resort Kempinski in Dominica, though still in its first phase, has begun. On Thursday, construction works were actively ongoing and the first concrete was poured a few days

On October 16, 2015, Range Developments Limited and Kempinski Hotel Group broke ground for a Kempinski brand luxury hotel in Dominica. The resort, which will be situated at Douglas Bay in the north-west part of the island, will be a 100-room romance suite hotel

The construction of the resort is expected to create hundreds of jobs for Dominicans during the construction period. The Cabrits Resort Kempinski is the first government-approved real estate project under Dominica's citizenship by investment program

The resort is scheduled to be completed in the fourth quarter of 2018.
